This was brother Oral Robert's favorite saying, and it should be ours as well. The Bible plainly tells us that if we are born-again Christians, we are God's children.

Well, if I'm a child of God, I shouldn't be beat up by the devil! One of the reasons Satan has had advantage over us at times is because we drop our faith shield. Ephesians 6:16 KJV Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Faith is what causes good things to happen to us. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Matthew 9:21-22 KJV For she said within herself, If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole. [22] But Jesus turned Him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Matthew 8:26 KJV And He saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then He arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.

Matthew 6:30 KJV Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall He not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?

Matthew 9:28-30 KJV And when He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yea, Lord. [29] Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. [30] And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it .

Luke 18:35, 40-42 KJV And it came to pass, that as He was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging: [40] And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him: and when he was come near, He asked him, [41] Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. [42] And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.

God wants us to live our lives expecting the good to happen to us. If this is going to happen, we must recognize that God has made a covenant with us through the Lord Jesus Christ.

Genesis 6:17-18 KJV And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under Heaven; and every thing that is in the earth shall die. [18] But with thee will I establish My covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.

God warned Noah of the flood that was coming, but that it would not kill him or his family because of the Covenant that God would establish with him

This is the definition of Covenant: The conditional promises made to humanity by God, as revealed in Scripture.

The agreement between God and the ancient Israelites, in which God promised to protect them if they kept His law and were faithful to Him

We have entered into the New Covenant through accepting Jesus as our Savior, and now we can expect that God will protect us and watch over us. Something good is going to happen to us everyday, because we have a Covenant with God through Jesus. Get ready for your Covenant blessings today!

Psalm 23:1-6 KJV

[1] The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want.

[2] He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: He leadeth me beside the still waters.

[3] He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.

[4] Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.

[5] Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: Thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

[6] Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.
