**Ephesians 1:3 KJV** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

Does the Church think blessed or do they think cursed? That is what this Newsletter is about today.

The power of God is available to any believer in Jesus; there is nothing impossible to them, but they must believe that God has given them that power through their faith in Christ.

Years ago, God started showing me His awesome plan to bless His children. We will study some verses today that will prove that God is no respecter of persons. If He will bless one, He will bless all that believe. The Bible is full of God's legal promises to us. He guarantees that they will come to pass in our lives by His Son's very own blood.

**Galatians 3:7-9 KJV** Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

[8] And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed. [9] So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Because we are children of Abraham, we are blessed with him through Christ.

**Galatians 3:29 KJV** And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

I've learned over the years that I must think blessed to receive the blessing. What we believe is a result of what we think. If we don't think the words of the Bible, we will never believe them. That is why we should be searching the Scriptures daily to find out what God wants us to receive from Him.

Children that grow up in poverty usually will be poverty-stricken adults, unless they get around some people that will challenge them that they don't have to be poor. I've learned that people that are non believers in Jesus

sometimes will live better lives than believers, just because they have a positive way of thinking.

He wants to fill our lives with His blessings so that we can, in turn, give to others from what He has given us.

**Genesis 12:1-3 KJV** Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: [2] And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: [3] And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Remember, we are the children of Abraham; and we are blessed because Abraham believed. We must think and believe like Abraham to experience God's blessed life. I want you to study this verse, and replace Abraham's name with yours.

**Genesis 24:1 KJV** And Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.
