

I See God's Goodness Being Applied To Me

God's plan for us is good, not evil; but the devil is always trying to stop it. The devil has power over a believer only when the believer believes the wrong thing. So many Christians believe that only when they get to Heaven will they have power over the devil. But they won't need it then, because the devil won't be there! Christians must learn that they have power over the devil NOW. When we keep the devil from stopping it, God's good plan will be fulfilled in our lives!

I have some Scripture verses that teach us how to win over our adversary.

Psalm 27:1-5, 10-14 KJV The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

[2] When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

[3] Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.

[4] One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in His temple.

[5] For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion: in the secret of His tabernacle shall He hide me; He shall set me up upon a rock.

[10] When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take me up.

[11] Teach me Thy way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

[12] Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

[13] I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.

[14] Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and He shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord .

Now I want you to recognize in these Scriptures that when David was writing this Psalm, he was showing us how to win over our enemy, the devil. We must think and talk victorious! We must not think or talk as though our enemy has power over us. We must speak about our God giving us victory over the devil. We must never think, talk, or act like the devil has any power over us.

The more you see yourself as God's special, favorite child and that He has only good planned for you, the more the devil will lose his power to deceive you. Then the devil's lies will be exposed, and God will be able to fill your life with His goodness.

I encourage you today to read the promises in the Bible directed to believers, because we are believers. Let those promises give you insight into God's plans for you. Then expect them to come to pass in your life.
