

## If We Believe He Will, God Will Act on the Words We Speak

Mark [11:22-23](#) KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

[23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

In verse 22, Jesus tells us to have faith in God; then in the 23rd verse He said to believe that what we say will come to pass. So He is saying that if we believe in our words coming to pass, we are having faith in God.

Over the years, I have watched my Father God bring so many things to pass that I have spoken. So I am a living witness that these verses are true. But, I still have to fight the good fight of faith to hold on to the revelation that I am the deciding factor on what God does in my life. Jesus already did everything that needed to be done for me and you to live the best life! Now it is up to us to bury our minds in the revelation that God will act on our words. We make it happen by saying what God has already said to us in the Bible.

I remember a long time ago I was going through some major adversities in my life. I would go to God in prayer believing that He would do something to help me if I just bugged Him enough. You know what I mean, because we have all done it. I was trying to talk God into doing something for me. I really didn't believe that I could just say the Word, and it would come to pass. But one day I recognized that I was going about it all wrong. God had already told me that I could have anything that the Bible said I could have, but I realized that I must use the law of faith to receive them. The number one rule of faith in the New Testament is to find the promises that God has said we can have, meditate on them until they are in our heart, then speak them in faith and start praising God for bringing them to pass in our lives.

If you want God to manifest in your life, you must recognize that He will show up when you start speaking His Word in faith. The devil wants you to think it is just too good to be true, but remember he is a liar. Over the years, many of us have only been under authority and have never been in authority, so we would just wait for someone to tell us what to do. This is what is happening with a lot of Christians. They are waiting on God, but God is waiting on them to say something in faith. Then He will actually submit Himself to His own Word that is coming out of the person's mouth and will bring it to pass.
