

House of Prayer - part two

Matthew [21:12-14](#) KJV And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, [13] And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves. [14] And the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple; and He healed them.

We know that the temple of God in the Old Testament was a building made with material goods. The temple in the New Testament is every Christian. Let us look at some Scripture that bears this out.

2 Corinthians [6:16](#) KJV And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

In this verse we see very plainly that God now lives in the believers. We know that God is in Heaven sitting on His throne; but God's Spirit is on the earth living inside the Church. Believers in Jesus are the Church. God has chosen to live in us, walk in us, and do His work through us.

When I got this revelation and started acknowledging that God's Person lived inside of me, I started having communion with Him. (Now I don't mean taking communion as when we eat the bread and drink the juice) I mean talking and listening to God inside me. I started hearing His voice that came up from inside me.

God and I started having communion. I started sharing His life and He was sharing my life. So many good things have happened since I got this revelation. When Jesus said that His house shall be called the house of prayer, He really meant it. Because we are the temple of God, we are the house of prayer; so we must acknowledge that God is in us, then we must put prayer as the number one priority in our lives. Over and over again in the Bible we see God saying things like this...

Mark [11:24](#) KJV Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them .

Matthew [7:11](#) KJV If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in Heaven give good things to them that ask Him?

John 15:7 KJV If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

All throughout the Bible we see the laws of the Spirit being operated in through prayer. When I say the 'laws of the Spirit' what I mean is the rules that govern the Spirit of God's actions that bring change to the people in this world we live in. When Christian people do not pray and intercede, it limits God from doing what He desires to do in this world. In Heaven there are no limitations of God; but on the earth, God is limited if people don't pray. The reason for this is because God has put man in charge of the earth. Our prayers are actually inviting God into the earth to help us do what He desires for us to do.

If you haven't yet become God's house of prayer, make a decision right now that you will put prayer first place in your life.
