

## God's Love (continued from last week)

Let us start this week's Newsletter by recognizing that a Christian never has to fail or lose in this life once they begin to operate in the love of God that has been put in them at their new birth.

1 Corinthians 13:7-8 AMP Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything without weakening. [8] Love never fails never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end. As for prophecy (the gift of interpreting the divine will and purpose), it will be fulfilled and pass away; as for tongues, they will be destroyed and cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away it will lose its value and be superseded by truth.

We see in these verses that the love of God will outlast even the gifts of the Spirit! When a Christian puts the love of God first place in their lives, they will see God start producing Heaven on the earth for them. I want you to study these next verses and take them as promises from your Heavenly Father.

Ephesians [3:17-19](#) AMP May Christ through your faith actually dwell (settle down, abide, make His permanent home) in your hearts! May you be rooted deep in love and founded securely on love, [18] That you may have the power and be strong to apprehend and grasp with all the saints God's devoted people, the experience of that love what is the breadth and length and height and depth of it; [19] That you may really come to know practically, through experience for yourselves the love of Christ, which far surpasses mere knowledge without experience; that you may be filled through all your being unto all the fullness of God may have the richest measure of the divine Presence, and become a body wholly filled and flooded with God Himself!

The Lord wants us to know that if we operate in His love, we will live like He lives. When Jesus had the woman caught in adultery presented to Him, He didn't judge her; He just said I don't condemn you, go and sin no more. This is God's love in operation.

John 8:7-11 NCV When they continued to ask Jesus their question, He raised up and said, "Anyone here who has never sinned can throw the first stone at her." [8] Then Jesus bent over again and wrote on the ground. [9] Those who heard Jesus began to leave one by one, first the older men and then the others. Jesus was left there alone with the woman standing before Him. [10] Jesus raised up again and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one judged you guilty?" [11] She answered, "No one, sir." Then Jesus said, "I also don't judge you guilty. You may go now, but don't sin anymore."]

We are living in a world today that has almost everybody accusing each other. Can you imagine what it would be like if everybody lived in the God-kind of Love?

I know Heaven has no sin in it. God sent His Son to take our sins away by His blood. We must see the blood of Jesus removing our brothers' and our sisters' sins, and treat them with God's love.
