

God's Words Spoken in Faith Move the Holy Spirit and the Angels into ACTION

The reason God's Spirit brings good things to pass in our lives is because of our faith and confession. Let us look at some Scriptures that bear this out

Romans 10:8-10 KJV But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; [9] That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

I want you to think about this...When a person that is not a Christian decides to become a Christian, how do they do it? In these verses we see it is done by believing with the heart that God raised Jesus from the dead and confessing with the mouth the Lord Jesus. In verse 10 He says that confession is made unto salvation. Now let's put it all together. The Holy Spirit brings salvation and the new birth to a person when they believe and speak. This is an awesome revelation! Mankind was created to speak their own destiny! God works with man, as they speak, to bring to pass what they believe, if it is in accordance to what the Bible says.

Over the years I've used this principle, and I've watched God bring to pass what He has spoken in His word. So many people think that God does all the choosing for them. They think whatever God wants will come to pass without them having anything to do with it. This is a trick of the devil. People are sitting waiting on God, and God is waiting on them to believe and speak what the Bible says concerning their situations.

I want you to meditate on these Bible events, and you will see that God did something because people believed and spoke.

Mark 5:25-34 KJV And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,[26] And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, [27] When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched His garment. [28] For she said, If I may touch but His clothes, I shall be whole. [29] And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. [30] And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that virtue had gone out of Him, turned Him about in the press, and said, Who touched My clothes? [31] And His disciples said unto Him, Thou seest the multitude thronging Thee, and sayest Thou, Who touched Me? [32] And He looked round about to see her that had done this thing. [33] But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before Him, and told Him all the truth. [34] And He said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

Matthew 8:5-13 KJV And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching Him, [6] And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. [7] And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. [8] The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. [9] For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it . [10] When Jesus heard it, He marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. [11] And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of Heaven. [12] But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of

teeth. [13] And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

The centurion knew that all Jesus had to do was speak, and his servant would be healed. He knew that Jesus could have what He said come to pass. God wants His church to know that they can do the same thing with their words, if they believe that their words will come to pass. The Holy Spirit will back them up with power to bring to pass what they say in faith.

Mark [11:22-23](#) KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Genesis [1:26](#) KJV And God said, Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

We see God made us like Him in His own image. We can have what we say come to pass, because we are like Him. I encourage you to speak what God wants in your life, and He will honor your words and bring them to pass. Let me give you some more Scripture to speak that will bless you.

Exodus 23:25-26 KJV And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and He shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. [26] There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Isaiah 54:17 KJV No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of Me, saith the Lord .
