

The Supernatural Church

Are you desiring to live a life surrendered to God? Do you desire to have the power of God flow through you? If your answer is 'yes' to these questions, this Newsletter is for you.

When I began listening to Brother Kenneth Copeland on TV in 1980, something really changed in my life. He preached about God doing supernatural things through the Church.

Now, I've always been a visionary. Even as a little boy, I would use my imagination at sports or hunting. When I got married at the age of 18, I wasn't fully matured yet; but I was a big dreamer. (LeJeune took a big chance marrying me, but after almost 50 years of marriage, it has paid off!)

So when Brother Copeland said that God has never changed His way of doing things and that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever, I began envisioning myself doing the supernatural! When he said those things, it changed my mind forever!

Hebrews 13:8 KJV Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever.

When Brother Copeland preached on this verse, I knew beyond a shadow of a doubt that God never intended for the Church to stop doing supernatural works. The Church has settled for reading the history of the Bible instead of making history.

Now I want you to think about something that will cause you to desire the supernatural ways of God. The book of Acts is the account of God doing supernatural things through natural man. In Acts the second chapter, Jesus had already left Earth and gone to Heaven; then He sent the Holy Ghost, and the Church was birthed. The followers of Jesus were full of power and the Holy Ghost, and they immediately started doing miracles. It was like Jesus was still on the earth. There was powerful preaching and teaching in those days; just like we have today. But something was different then; the Word preached had signs and wonders happening with it.

In 30 years of ministry, I've had some miraculous things happen through the power of the Holy Ghost; but I don't think we have seen anything yet. If Jesus is coming quickly, and I believe He is, we need to get prepared for the greatest supernatural outpouring. The Church must believe that God wants to fill them with His Spirit and flow out of them. When the Holy Ghost does healing and miracles through us, the world will start listening to our preaching and teaching.

I would like for you to study 2 Kings, chapters 1-4. With this in mind, Elijah is a type of Jesus; and Elisha is a type of the Church. As you read the accounts of these two men, remember that they represent our supernatural God and the supernatural Church. If you want to be a part of this supernatural way of living, imagine yourself as Elisha.

I will give you a couple of verses from what you will be studying to whet your appetite.

2 Kings 2:9-10 KJV And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me. [10] And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: nevertheless, if thou see me when I am taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be so.

Jesus has been taken up, and we are on the earth with His power to do the same works- and greater. Get ready for your life to radically change!
