

The Power of the Gospel

The Gospel has power to bring salvation, wholeness, soundness, and deliverance. When we received Jesus, we received all that God is. When Moses was told by God to tell Pharaoh to, "Let my people go", Moses asked God what he should say His Name is? Here is the account of God's answer.

Exodus [3:13-14](#) KJV And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them? [14] And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and He said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

When God said His Name is I AM THAT I AM, He was saying that He was all that they needed for them to be free from the Egyptians.

When we received Jesus, we received the Great I AM. When we need to be free from any curse the devil tries to put on us, we have the I AM to be free!

God tells us that in the Gospel is the power to be saved.

Romans [1:16](#) KJV For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

When a person receives Jesus, they have the promise of eternal life. We will always have God's abundant supply. Whatever we need, the Great I AM is there to bring it to pass.

But, I have a question for you: when does eternal life start? Does it start when we die and go to Heaven? Or did it start when we received Jesus as our Lord and Savior? The moment a person confesses Jesus as their Lord and Savior, eternal life starts for them. At that moment they receive the Great I AM. Whatever is needed to be free from the devil is given to us, when we receive it by faith.

The Israelites were led out of the Egyptians' bondage with the power of the Great I AM. We are led out the same way. God says to us today, "I'm the same 'I AM' today as I was then". He wants us to be free from the devil's curses, just like He wanted His children of Israel free from the Pharaoh.

Here are some Scriptures to study on this subject.

Exodus 7:1-2 KJV And the Lord said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet. [2] Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Exodus 15:1-4 KJV Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the Lord, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the Lord, for He hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath He thrown into the sea. [2] The Lord is my strength and song, and He is become my salvation: He is my God, and I will prepare Him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt Him. [3] The Lord is a man of war: the Lord is His Name. [4] Pharaoh's chariots and his host hath He cast into the sea: His chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea.
