

Read the Bible - to Believe the Bible - to Receive the Bible

The Bible is God's Promise Book that is the guarantee from God to all of His heirs. When someone who has written a will dies, there will be a reading of the will so that the heirs can know what they have inherited. When Jesus died, He also had a will; it is called the New Testament or the Will and Testament of Jesus Christ. Here is a Scripture that bears this out:

Hebrews [9:14-17](#) KJV How much more shall the blood of Christ, Who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? [15] And for this cause He is the mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. [16] For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. [17] For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.

We can see that the New Testament is actually a legal document that releases the inheritance of Jesus to us as His heirs. We should never read the Bible as a duty, but as a legal document with His Promises. Let me give you an example: A person with the job of counting other people's money in a bank is performing a duty. Now that same person counting their own money is thinking completely different. When we read the Bible, we should be finding out what God has given us through the death of Jesus.

Let me show you a couple of verses that should make you so happy.

Romans [8:16-17](#) KJV The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: [17] And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

God wants to bless His children with all that He has given Jesus, and that is everything that He owns!! But all of the heirs of God cannot receive what they rightfully own in Jesus without believing for it to manifest in their lives. Let me show you some verses that prove this.

Romans [4:13-16](#) KJV For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. [14] For if they which are of the law be heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: [15] Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression. [16] Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

So we should always read the Bible to believe the Bible to receive from the Bible.
