Are there benefits to attending Church regularly?

Hebrews 10:22-25 KJV Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. [23] Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) [24] And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: [25] Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is ; but exhorting one another : and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Verse 25 says 'not for forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as we see the day approaching'.

What day is he talking about? I believe he is talking about the dangerous times we live in.

Deuteronomy 32:30 KJV How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except their Rock had sold them, and the Lord had shut them up?

In this verse we see that when we join together there is more power to stop the enemy when he is attacking.

1 Corinthians 12:12, 18 KJV For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. [18] But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased Him.

When a person is saved, God desires for that person to grow up spiritually. They are born again as spiritual babies, and the local Church they attend will either cause them to grow or not to grow. It all depends on what spiritual food that Church is serving. I believe that God will never send a baby Christian to a Church that does not teach the Word of God. God has a special Church for every member of the body of Christ, and that Church will bring that believer into a spiritual maturity. When a believer is sent to that Church, the devil will try to get them out of the Church, that is his MO (Mode of Operation) to get people away from where they are being spiritually fed. Therefore, that Church and the believer must fight for each other. Today I want to encourage you to stay connected to the Church to which God has sent you. There is not supposed to be any 'Lone Rangers' in the body of Christ! If you have left the Church God sent you to, go back and get reconnected.
