He and his demons can rule us, if we allow him to by opting out of God's victorious plan for our lives.

Here is another statement in the Confession Booklet.

****I wait upon the Lord and He renews my strength. I will mount up with wings like eagles. I will run and not be weary. I will walk and not faint.**

Sometimes we will get tired as Christians. That's when we must go to our secret place and get alone with God. Play some worship songs, and just bathe in the presence of the Lord. Turn on an encouraging sermon from a preacher or teacher. As you listen, pray in tongues and allow the Holy Ghost to take every care away from you.
