

## Healing Is The Children's Bread

Mark 7:27 KJV But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs.

Just as it is the responsibility of parents to feed their children, it is also the responsibility of Jesus to heal His children. As we look through the New Testament, we see over and over again God's children being healed by God the Father and the Lord Jesus.

Luke 13:11-12 KJV And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself. [12] And when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

Matthew 4:23 KJV And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the Kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Matthew 8:13, 14-16 KJV And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour. [14] And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, He saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. [15] And He touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. [16] When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with His word, and healed all that were sick:

Matthew 12:15 KJV But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew Himself from thence: and great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all;

Matthew 14:14 KJV And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.

Now there are so many accounts in the Bible of Jesus healing the people that we cannot put them all down in this Newsletter; it would turn into a book! I just want you to believe that God was in the healing business then, and He has never stopped! He healed in the Old Testament, He healed in the New Testament, and He is still healing today.

I've learned over the last 30 years that, generally speaking, God's healing comes through belief. When God's children believe that He will heal them, they put themselves into the position to receive it. That is why I'm writing this Newsletter. I just want to remind you that God desires for you to be well. Let's look at some more Scriptures that bear this out.

Acts 5:14-16 KJV And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) [15] Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. [16] There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Notice that as the people were saved in the book of Acts, they were healed as well. God wants all of His children to expect to be healed. Healing is easy for God; all He needs is our faith. Faith is a spiritual law. When we believe God's Word, our faith activates God's Power to bring the healing.

Look what Jesus said to a blind man in Luke 18:39-42 KJV And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. [40] And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him: and when he was come near, He asked him, [41] Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. [42] And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.

Notice that Jesus said, "Your faith has saved you". Jesus didn't say that He had healed him; He said your faith did it. The Bible says in Romans 10:17 KJV So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

If God's people don't hear that He wants to heal them, they won't have faith to receive their healing. My mission, as a pastor, is for my congregation to have faith to receive everything God has promised them. That's why I keep on preaching the promises of God, so that they will have faith to receive everything God has promised...and healing is one of the biggest promises in the Bible!

As we close this Newsletter today, don't forget that faith comes by hearing. It didn't say it comes from what you've heard. We must constantly put ourselves in an environment where the promises of God are being preached. The Christian Center radio station is on the air to preach the Word so that faith can come. Also, the TCC app is a tool for you to use to keep faith coming to you. Don't neglect these powerful tools. God your Father wants you well.

Psalms 107:20 KJV He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
