Deuteronomy 7:9 KJV Know therefore that the Lord thy God, He is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations;

Psalm 36:5 KJV Thy mercy, O Lord , is in the heavens; and Thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds.

Psalm 89:1 KJV I will sing of the mercies of the Lord for ever: with my mouth will I make known Thy faithfulness to all generations.

Psalm 89:20-24 KJV I have found David My servant; with My holy oil have I anointed him: [21] With whom My hand shall be established: Mine arm also shall strengthen him. [22] The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him. [23] And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him. [24] But My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him: and in My Name shall his horn be exalted.

We see in these verses that because God is faithful, we can trust Him to keep our enemies from destroying us. God's power is released through His character of faithfulness. God cannot, and will not, ever lie to us; it goes against Who He is. We can truly put all our dependence on Him.

When we learn how faithful our Heavenly Father is, we will see our faith explode! We will be able to do things we have always wanted to do, but couldn't quite figure out how to do it.
