When we exercise faith in God being our Helper, we will find out really quickly that God's peace will come to bring comfort. If we believe the Bible on this subject, we can receive the help of God.

Psalm 33:18-20 (KJV) Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear Him, upon them that hope in His mercy; [19] To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. [20] Our soul waiteth for the Lord: He is our help and our shield.

In these verses, we see that God will help us whenever we fear the Lord. Now the word 'fear' is not defined as afraid. The fear of the Lord is the reverence of the Lord. When we give honor and reverence to the Lord, we are now in position to receive His help. Over the last 30 years, I've watched many people receive the Lord's help in their lives. Most of these people really do honor and reverence Him.

Now you might ask me, "What if I haven't given God honor, will He not help me?"

Well the answer to that question can be answered by the following verse in the Old Testament, where even when Israel didn't do right, God would still help them; if they would repent and come back to Him.

Hosea 13:9-10 KJV O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself; but in Me is thine help.

We were trained from the time we were babies to rely on people. As we grew up, we tended to put a lot of confidence in our education and training. If we are not careful, we will push God completely out of our lives. Living in this world today without God's help is a dangerous way to live. God loves us, but He can't help us, if we don't rely on Him. We must live our lives dependent on God, if we expect to experience what He has for us.

Following are some Scriptures for you to meditate on that will help you learn to trust your Heavenly Father.

Hebrews 13:6 AMP So we take comfort and are encouraged and confidently and boldly say, The Lord is my Helper; I will not be seized with alarm I will not fear or dread or be terrified. What can man do to me?

Psalm 118:4-9 (KJV) Let them now that fear the Lord say, that his mercy endureth for ever. [5] I called upon the Lord in distress: the Lord answered me, and set me in a large place. [6] The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me? [7] The Lord taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire upon them that hate me. [8] It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man. [9] It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in princes.

Psalm 121:1-8 (KJV) I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my

help. [2] My help cometh from the Lord, which made Heaven and Earth. [3] He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: He that keepeth thee will not slumber. [4] Behold, He that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. [5] The Lord is thy keeper: the Lord is thy shade upon thy right hand. [6] The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night. [7] The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: He shall preserve thy soul. [8] The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
